Lesson 1 — Facts, Fellowship, and Fullness of Joy — 1 John 1:1-4

Memory Verse- 1 John 1:4

1. Read I John 1:1-4. (a) What is John referring to in verse 1? (b) What had he heard, what had he seen, and what had he handled? (c) How do you know?

2. (a) According to verse 4, what is one purpose John writes this letter? (b) Should this fruit be evident in the life of a believer? (See Gal. 5:22,23) (c) What does it mean to have fullness of joy?

3. (a) What phrase is repeated in verses 1, 2, and 3? (b) Why do you think John repeats this phrase?

4. What do you think John means in verse 3 by the term “fellowship?”

5. (a) Do you have “fellowship with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ?” (b) How is this evident in your life?

6. According to the following verses, what should bring one fullness of joy? John 3:29; John 15:9-11; John 16:24; John 17:13; Phil. 2:2; II John 12. (By the way, who authored most of these verses?)

7. (a) How does your life exhibit fullness of joy? (b) If not, what is hindering that joy? (c) What will you do about it?
