

Questions for Consideration—*With the Master Remembering Precious Truths*
Lesson 7—The Descriptions and Depravity of False Teachers—2 Peter 2:10-17

1. (a) Read 2 Peter 2:10-17 out loud. (b) What is the first thing that comes to your mind after reading these verses? (c) What are the dangers of walking after the lust of the flesh according to this passage and Romans 8:4-13? (d) What are some practical ways we can make sure we are walking in the Spirit?
2. Memorize 2 Peter 2:17.
3. (a) What things are alike in 2 Peter 2:10-17 and the epistle of Jude? (b) Peter and Jude are both describing false teachers, but what does Romans chapter 1 say regarding mankind without Christ? (c) What warnings are there for us as we consider these passages?
4. One of the descriptions of false teachers Peter gives in 2 Peter 2 is that they are wells without water. With that in mind, what is the difference between what the false teachers provide compared to what Christ provides? See Isaiah 12:3; John 4:1-14; Revelation 22:17.
5. (a) What is the similarity between false teachers and Balaam according to 2 Peter 2:15,16? (b) In what ways did he love the wages of unrighteousness? (You will need to read Numbers chapters 22-24.) (c) What warnings are there for us when we consider these passages?
6. (a) What should be our response to false teachers according to Romans 16:17; 2 Thessalonians 3:6,14; 1 Timothy 6:3-5; Titus 1:10-16; Titus 3:10; 2 John 10,11? (b) How would you describe the false teachers of our day?
7. We are living in an age of apostasy, along with an increased number of false teachers. What should be our prayer as we see these things happening? Please write yours down to share with your group.
