Lesson 8—The Dishonesty and Devastation of False Teachers—2 Peter 2:18-22

1. Read 2 Peter chapter 2 and summarize it in three sentences.
2. Memorize 2 Peter 2:21.
3. (a) Peter writes in 1 Peter 5:1-4 regarding what a good shepherd looks like. Read that passage along with 2 Peter chapter 2 and write down as many contrasts as you see between true shepherds and false teachers. (b) Why do you think Peter gives so much space in his second epistle to the topic of false teachers?
4. (a) In what ways are Luke 11:24-26, Hebrews 6:4-8, and Hebrews 10:26, 27 like 2 Peter 2:20? (b) What warnings are there for us in these passages?
5. (a) What would be some dangers of turning away from the truth of God's Word? (b) How do we avoid becoming apathetic about the Word of God and our responsibility to it?
6. (a) If you were exposed to someone who lived out 2 Peter 2:18-22, what would you do? (b) If you knew someone who was listening to false teachers, how would you help them?
7. We have now completed an entire chapter on false teachers. I pray your heart is grieved at what damage they have done to the church. Please write a request to God for the false teachers of our day and those who follow them.
