

Questions for Consideration—*With the Master Remembering Precious Truths*
Lesson 10 — Remembering the Attributes of God as it Pertains to End Times. — 2 Peter 3: 8-10

1. (a) Read 2 Peter 3:8-10. What attributes of God does Peter mention in these verses? (b) How do these attributes give hope and warning as it relates to the coming of the Lord?
2. Memorize 2 Peter 3:9.
3. (a) Compare 2 Peter 3 with Matthew 24:11-51. What things are similar with these two passages? (b) What are the warnings in these passages? (c) What comfort is there in these passages?
4. (a) How does Isaiah describe the catastrophic events in 2 Peter 3:10, that is, the earth being burned up? See Isaiah 13:10-11; 24:19; 34:4; 51:5-6; and 64:1-4. (b) Why is God going to destroy the earth, according to the Isaiah passages?
5. (a) Peter mentions the longsuffering of God in hopes that men will repent. How else is the Lord's longsuffering shown according to Exodus 34:6; Romans 9:22; 1 Timothy 1:16; 1 Peter 3:20 and 2 Peter 3:15? (b) In what ways has the Lord been longsuffering in your life?
6. (a) How would you use these verses in 2 Peter 3:8-10 to encourage those who are impatient for the Lord's return? (b) How would you use them to defend the Lord's return to those who are scoffers?
7. Peter is clear that God is longsuffering and not willing that any should perish. Who are those that you desire to come to the knowledge of salvation? Please write a prayer request for their souls to be saved before that great and terrible day of the Lord comes.
