Lesson 11 — How Should We Live in View of the End of the World? — 2 Peter 3:11-16

1. (a) Read 2 Peter 3:11-16. How should believers live their lives in light of the end of the world? (b) Are you living in this manner? (c) In what ways do you see Christendom living in this manner? (d) Where are we failing?
2. Memorize 2 Peter 3:11
3. (a) What things are noted in the following verses regarding the new heaven and the new earth or the end of the earth? Psalm 102: 25,26; Isaiah 51:6; Matthew 24:35; Romans 8:18-21; 1 Corinthians 7:29-31 and Revelation 20:11, 21:1-5. (b) How would you describe each of these events?
4. (a) What will the new heaven and earth be like according to Revelation 21 and 22 and Isaiah 65 and 66? (b) Why do you think we cling to this world when the next one will be far better? (c) What are you looking forward to the most when you think about the new heaven and the new earth?
5. (a) What do you think Peter means about hastening the day of the Lord in 2 Peter 3:12? (b) What do you think 2 Peter 3:15 and 16 means?
6. How could you use this lesson to lovingly warn unbelievers of what is to come?
7. After prayerfully considering your answers to question one, please write a prayer request for yourself as to how you might better be prepared for the end.
