

Questions for Consideration—*With the Master In Heavenly Places*

Lesson 22 — A Final Prayer, A Faithful Friend and Farewell Words of the Apostle Paul — Ephesians 6:18-24

1. (a) Why is it important that we pray according to Ephesians 6:18-20? (b) Why do you think it is important for you to pray?
2. Paul says we are to persevere in our praying in Ephesians 6:18. What encouragement can you take from Matthew 26:36-46 and Luke 18:3-7 as you persevere in prayer?
3. Memorize Ephesians 6:18.
4. (a) What do you learn about Tychicus in Acts 20:4, 5; Ephesians 6:21-22, Colossians 4:7, 8; 1 Timothy 4:12; Titus 3:12? (b) How does Tychicus compare with some of the others who were with Paul at one time according to 2 Timothy 1:15; 2:17, 18; 4:14, and 4:10? (c) What qualities would you look for in someone you would minister with?
5. Read over all of Ephesians and write down any new truths you have learned as well as changes you have made as a result of the study.
6. Looking back at lesson 1 what was your answer on what you hoped to gain from this study? Did you achieve it?
7. Write out a praise or thanksgiving to God for what He has taught you through this study as well as a prayer request that includes what your plan of action will be to obey what you have learned!
